

RITUAL COMPETITION

Competition will be held at Grand Officers' or Grand Representatives' Day/Night at Hostess Assembly beginning at 11AM or 3 PM.

Proper dress attire for a Rainbow meeting will be required.

If you take first place in a category, you may **NOT** repeat that event.

Pins will be presented to all participants with the first place winner receiving an extra pin. To achieve first place award, you must have a score of at least 90%. You may compete in only one category a year unless you are doing All Round and then you may compete in two.

After the awards are presented at Grand Assembly girls will be given their score sheets to assist them in future endeavors.

Pins will be awarded in the following permanent categories.

1. **“The First Twelve Hours of Rainbow”**- Girls who have been in Rainbow less than one year
Bring letter from MA with date of initiation
2. **Bow Station**- girls who have been in Rainbow less than two years.
Bring letter from MA with date of initiation
3. **Rhode Island Flag Tribute**- ALL THREE STANZAS. Mother Advisors will have this.
Girls in Rainbow more than two years.
4. **Rose Lecture**- All who are interested
5. **Ceremony of Color**- All who are interested
6. **Dad’s Talk**- All who are interested
7. **Charity Initiation Lecture**- line officers who are not Worthy Advisor or Past Worthy Advisor
8. **Worthy Advisor**- Initiation Obligation plus obligation and installation of Worthy Advisor-
Worthy Advisors who are serving a first or second consecutive term
9. **Believe in the Rainbow**- Must be in at least five years
10. **All Round** - Must be able to do all of Worthy Advisor, introductions, floor set up, jewels, and whatever else is requested. There will be 20 written and up to ten verbal or visual questions
